- Project demonstrates leading-edge ethics of research with indigenous communities;
- Project will generate knowledge that will have far-reaching impacts in Canada and beyond;
- A creative knowledge mobilization plan is put forward in the project objectives and schedule, including communication of results to indigenous communities.

Project duration should be of 2-3 years

- * **This year, funding for postdoctoral fellowship will be allocated following a call for postdoctoral projects. No funding will be available directly to postdoctoral student through this call for proposals.**
